Flexible Learning Opportunities for Cambodian Youth

Online-Based Learning

Learners can learn anytime, anywhere, with internet data provided.



On-going Support

Facilitators in each learning center will provide on-going support until learners complete the programme successfully.



Orientation

Learners will be guided on how to learn online. Career counselling service will also be provided by the facilitators.



Get Basic Education Certificate

Upon completion, learners can continue their skills training at TVET institutes or Technical High Schools.



Internet Access and Smart Devices:

At the nearest learning centers, learners can come and use smart devices such as tablets and computers with free internet access.

What is BEEP?

The Basic Education Equivalency Programme

BEEP is a joint initiative of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport (MoEYS), the Ministry of Labour and Vocational Training (MLVT) and UNESCO to provide flexible alternative online education to out-of-school youth to complete lower secondary/basic education, equivalent to Grade 9. The BEEP is an online-based programme aiming at helping young Cambodians aged 14 and older, especially those who drop out from lower secondary education, to complete their basic education through online courses in ways that will not affect their ability to work while pursuing their education. Learners who complete the BEEP will receive a certificate which enables them to enroll in skills training either at TVET institutes or at Technical High Schools. There is no fee for accessing the programme. Learners who do not have a personal smartphone or computer can come to BEEP learning centers which are equipped with internet access, tablet devices, computers and facilitators to support them.

HOW BEEP WORKS?



1. Registration

Learners can enroll in the BEEP at the nearest learning center, or they can register online.



2. Choice of studies

Learners can take Core Subjects and General Subjects to continue to Technical High Schools or take Core Subjects and Technical Subjects to continue to TVET institutes. Learners can take all 11 subjects if they wish to.



3. Support

By learning in a blended system, learners get assistance from the facilitators and volunteers at the learning centers while taking online course to improve and evaluate their learning progress.



4. Completion

Students need to take final exam upon the completion of required subjects. Students who pass final exam will be awarded basic education certificate (equivalent to Grade 9), which allows them to pursue further education either at TVET or technical high school.

LEARNING OPTIONS AND PATHWAYS

The BEEP learners can choose the following options to learn:

Study Core Subjects and General Subjects will receive a certificate equivalent to Grade 9 which enables them to continue to a **Technical High Schools under the MoEYS**

Study Core Subjects and Technical Subjects will receive a certificate equivalent to Grade 9 which enables them to continue enrolling in

TVET institutes under the MLVT

Study all 11 subjects will receive a certificate equivalent to Grade 9 which enables them to continue to both in

Technical High Schools under the MoEYS and TVET institutes under the MLVT.

CERTIFICATION

The BEEP is officially accredited by the Royal Government of Cambodia. Learners who complete the required subjects and pass the final exam will receive a certificate which enables them to enroll in skills training either at TVET Institutes or Technical High Schools, equivalent to Cambodian Qualifications Framework level 2 (CQF2) or Certificate Level 1 of TVET.
